Hsinchu, Taiwan – May 12, 2026 - ChipMOS TECHNOLOGIES INC. (“ChipMOS” or the “Company”) (Taiwan Stock Exchange: 8150 and Nasdaq: IMOS), an industry leading provider of outsourced semiconductor assembly and test services (“OSAT”), today reported consolidated financial results for the first quarter ended March 31, 2026. All U.S. dollar figures cited in this press release are based on the exchange rate of NT\$32.05 against US\$1.00 as of March 31, 2026.

All the figures were prepared in accordance with Taiwan-International Financial Reporting Standards (“Taiwan-IFRS”).

Revenue for the first quarter of 2026 was NT\$6,935.6 million or US\$216.4 million, an increase of 6.4% from NT\$6,521.1 million or US\$203.5 million in the fourth quarter of 2025 and an increase of 25.4% from NT\$5,532.3 million or US\$172.6 million for the same period in 2025.

Net non-operating income in the first quarter of 2026 was NT\$78.5 million or US\$2.4 million, compared to net non-operating expenses of NT\$23.8 million or US\$0.7 million in the fourth quarter of 2025, and net non-operating income of NT\$82.1 million or US\$2.6 million in the first quarter of 2025. The difference between the fourth quarter of 2025 is mainly due to the positive impact on the share of associates accounted for using equity method of NT\$130 million or US\$4.1 million from the share of loss of associates accounted for using equity method of NT\$111 million or US\$3.5 million to the share of profit of associates accounted for using equity method of NT\$19 million or US\$0.6 million and partially offset by the decrease of foreign exchange gains of NT\$40 million or US\$1.2 million.

Net profit attributable to equity holders of the Company for the first quarter of 2026 was NT\$504.9 million or US\$15.8 million, and NT\$0.72 or US\$0.02 per basic common share, as compared to NT\$499.7 million or US\$15.6 million, and NT\$0.72 or US\$0.02 per basic common share in the fourth quarter of 2025. This compares to NT\$176.3 million or US\$5.5 million, and NT\$0.24 or US\$0.01 per basic common share in the first quarter of 2025. Net earnings for the first quarter of 2026 were US\$0.45 per basic ADS, compared to US\$0.45 per basic ADS for the fourth quarter of 2025 and US\$0.15 per basic ADS in the first quarter of 2025.

Net free cash flow for the first quarter of 2026 was NT\$1,109.3 million or US\$34.6 million with a strong balance of cash and cash equivalents of NT\$12,386.9 million or US\$386.5 million.

Company Comment:

ChipMOS’ recent performance reflects strong, structurally driven demand led by AI-related applications, particularly in data center markets, where a persistent demand–supply imbalance continues to support growth and pricing. The Company is benefiting from robust demand for high-value memory solutions, driving both volume and mix improvement, while operating in a capacity-constrained environment that enhances utilization and revenue quality. This dynamic, combined with an improving semiconductor cycle and increasing customer visibility, positions ChipMOS for sustained growth momentum.



ChipMOS continues to balance its capital allocation strategy by investing in the long-term capacity and revenue generation areas that will drive its success, while returning value to shareholders.

Semiannual Conference Calls:

As previously announced on November 11, 2025, after a period of internal review, the Company decided to move to semiannual conference calls from quarterly conference calls, with no conference call being held in conjunction with today's results press release. Financial reporting of operation results per regulation will remain reviewed by the Company's accountant quarterly, approved by our Board and then published. As of now, the Company's plans to host a conference call for the first 6 months results of 2026. Although the timing of the Company's conference calls has changed, it remains very accessible to investors and analysts and will be participating in upcoming investment forums and conferences, and other various investor and analyst meetings to enhance communication with investors and ensure a more complete understanding of the Company's operating environment and financial results.
