

ChipMOS TECHNOLOGIES INC.
Privacy Protection Policy

Article 1 The Privacy Protection Policy

This Privacy Protection Policy (the "**Policy**") describes how ChipMOS TECHNOLOGIES INC. (the "**Company**") processes your personal data. The scope of this Policy applies not only to customers' personal data but also includes suppliers' information. Any employee who violates this Policy will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Company's internal regulations. the Company reserves the right to update or amend this Policy at any time. We encourage you to review this Policy periodically for any updates.

Article 2 Personal Data Collection

The Company collects or obtains your personal data under the following circumstances: when you provide information to the Company; when information is obtained based on the legal relationship between you and the Company; when your personal data is made public by you; when you visit the Company's website; when you register on any of the Company's websites to use the Company's websites, products, or services; or when you interact with any third-party content or advertisements on the Company's websites. In addition, the Company may also obtain your personal data from third parties.

Article 3 Personal Data Established by the Company

Under certain circumstances, the Company may establish personal data relating to you, such as records of your interactions with the Company or records of past interactions. the Company may combine personal data obtained from the Company's websites, products, or services, including data collected from different devices, and may record and utilize such data accordingly.

Article 4: Categories of Personal Data Processed by the Company

The Company may process the following categories of personal data: personal information; demographic information; your contact information; records of your consent; order details; payment information; information regarding the Company's website; your employer information; information regarding your interactions with the content and advertisements on the Company's website; opinions and feedback you provide to the Company; records of communications between you and the Company; cookie data; security information; and visitor logs.

Article 5 Special Categories of Personal Data

Within the scope of the Company's ordinary business operations, the Company does not proactively collect or process special categories of personal data. If, for legitimate reasons, it is necessary to collect or process special categories of personal data, the Company shall collect and process such data within the following purposes:

1. To comply with relevant legal requirements: the Company may process your special categories of personal data within the scope required or permitted by relevant laws and regulations;
2. For the investigation or prevention of crime: the Company may process your special categories of personal data as necessary for the investigation or prevention of crime;
3. For the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal rights: the Company may process your special categories of personal data as necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal rights;
4. Based on your consent: the Company may process your special categories of personal data upon obtaining your prior explicit consent in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

When you provide special categories of personal data to the Company, please first ensure that you are duly authorized to disclose such information to the Company.

Article 6 Purposes and Legal Basis for the Processing of Personal Data by the Company

The Company processes your personal data for the following purposes: to provide you with websites, products, and services; compliance review; corporate operations; communication with you; management of the Company's information systems; supplier management; health and safety; financial management; opinion surveys; ensuring the security of the Company's premises and systems; judicial investigations; compliance with relevant laws; improvement of the Company's websites, products, and services; fraud prevention; where necessary for the establishment, exercise, or protection of legal rights; and recruitment and interviews.

Article 7 Recipients of Personal Data Shared by the Company

The Company may share your personal data with the following third parties: competent authorities under the law; the Company's external advisors; the Company's service providers; third parties to whom disclosure is necessary for the purposes of litigation or other legal proceedings; third parties to whom disclosure is necessary for the investigation, detection, or prevention of crime; third parties acquiring all or part of the Company's business or assets; and third parties providing advertisements,

plugins, or content for the Company's website.

Article 8 Your Personal Rights

Pursuant to applicable laws and regulations, you are entitled to exercise the following rights with respect to your personal data: the right to refuse to provide personal data; the right to access your personal data; the right to rectify inaccurate personal data; the right to request erasure; the right to restrict the processing of your personal data; the right to object to the processing of your personal data; the right to request the transfer of your personal data to another data controller; the right to withdraw your consent; and the right to lodge a complaint with the competent authority for information protection. In certain circumstances, you may be required to provide identification documents in order to exercise the aforementioned rights. Subject to compliance with legal requirements, you may also exercise the following rights: the right to object, based on your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data by the Company or any third party processing your personal data on behalf of the Company; and the right to object to the processing of your personal data by the Company or any third party processing your personal data on behalf of the Company for the purpose of direct marketing.

Article 9 Use of Customer Data for Purposes Other Than Those Specified

The Company is committed to protecting the privacy rights of the Company's customers and, therefore, will not use the customer information collected for any purposes other than those specified in this Policy.

Article 10 Dedicated Department

The Legal Department of the Company shall serve as the dedicated unit for personal data protection, responsible for implementing and supervising compliance with the privacy protection policy.
